Public Health and CCAC are co-located with the PEFHT and we have developed close relationships with our many community partners. Together, we have a roster of over 20,000 patients and provide primary care and other services to another 3,000.

There are many varied opportunities in which to be involved, depending on your interests and skills. These include Inpatient care in our local hospital (staffed by Family Doctors), Emergency shifts, procedure clinics, Sexual Health Clinics, Nursing Home care and palliative care. This is a Family Medicine rural teaching site associated with Queens University and there are opportunities for teaching Family Medicine Residents and Medical Students.

The environment of the team is that of support, collegiality, innovation, interprofessional learning, and a culture that encourages work/life balance.

Office space is available in a location with other physicians and health professionals. Many resources are already in place and a wealth of support is available for office set-up and staffing, mentoring, and assistance with seeking spousal career opportunities.
